




# A Letter From Our Pastor

Another year has come and gone, and here we are -11 years old! Our 12th year began a little unconventionally due to the COVID restrictions. After three weeks of distance learning, we happily welcomed our students back to the campus. Our current enrollment of 231 puts us at capacity - a far cry from the 23 students with whom we opened the school in 2009!

This will be another milestone year for Annunciation as our campus building project is well underway. The new school buildings are close to completion with a hoped-for move-in date sometime in December. This year's 8th grade class will be the first to graduate from the new building. In addition to the two classroom buildings, the campus project includes new outdoor athletic and play areas and a beautiful permanent Church and courtyard. The Church is expected to be completed in the fall of 2021.

It is amazing to reflect on how far we have come in our first decade. From the moment of its inception, it has been abundantly clear that God willed this school into being. Through His continued Grace, Annunciation has overcome many challenges and obstacles, and has become a successful and thriving school. It also took the time, talent, and treasure of many people to bring this school to where it is today and ensure a strong tomorrow. We are grateful for the many angels among us whose faith, service, financial support, and prayers have helped us become the school God wants us to be.

## Our Philosophy



# St. Gabriel Campus Update





St. Gabriel the Archangel Catholic Parish was founded in 2002 initially with temporary buildings for our worship space, and eventually those buildings became school classrooms when a more permanent building was erected to provide a larger worship space. Seventeen years later,

on November 17, 2019, the Bishop Thomas J. Olmsted of the Diocese of Phoenix celebrated Mass with the St. Gabriel community and performed the groundbreaking ceremony for our new permanent Church and school.

The new permanent Church and school buildings were designed by the Phoenix Design Group, LLC and is being built by Forefront Construction. Our new church is over 23,000-square-feet, with a 12,900-

square-foot worship space that will seat approximately 900 people, along with a chapel that seats 90.


The new school is two buildings with one contiguous roof separated by a breezeway that leads to our outdoor lunch pavilion on the north side and the playground and sport court area on the south side. Our Kindergarten through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classrooms and resource learning room are in

the east building. The middle school classrooms, art/ maker space, music and science room are in the west building. Both buildings have a center gathering area for small group work. The center breezeway provides access to the student restrooms, handwashing stations, outside

> water fountains and access to the staff room, which are all included in the west building.

> While the campus was closed for the early part of the pandemic, construction continued, keeping us on track for our move in December 2020. The construction on the Church will continue throughout the Spring and Summer with a projected completion date of October 2021.

We thank all who have prayed for and supported the build of our new church and school. We are truly blessed and we know that this was only made possible for our school and parish community by the grace of God and the desire of His faithful who were willing and able to provide the financial resources to make this dream a reality. God is good!

# National Junior Honor Society





## The James Rapisarda Chapter of National Junior Honor Society



On September 17, 2019, Annunciation Catholic School held its first National Junior Honor Society induction ceremony for the 8th-grade (Class of 2020). Family, friends and school staff gathered to formally recognize those students who were selected by the faculty council for successfully completing their candidacy. Sixteen 8th-grade students were inducted as inaugural members of the James Rapisarda Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society.



Students are eligible for candidacy if they earn a cumulative GPA of 3.85 or higher. In addition to their strong academic records, candidates must effectively demonstrate the five pillars that serve as standards for the Society; *Scholarship, Service, Leadership, Character, and Citizenship.* Our first candidates distinguish themselves as leaders in many student organizations and serve our school and community through many activities including the student ambassador program, Vibrant Vinnies service program, student council and more. We are proud of these accomplishments and look to these students as school leaders and role models.

After the first trimester, 7th-grade students (Class of 2021), had the opportunity to prove their eligibility for membership to NJHS. Their induction ceremony took place in January 2020 during Catholic Schools Week.

## Debi Gall Scholarship


