#### Welcome Back to School!

On Wednesday, August 11, the faculty and staff of Annunciation welcomed back the largest student body in our school's history. We have 236 students enrolled for the 2021-2022 school year with 41 students on the waitlist for grades 1-8. The return to school comes with a much appreciated parent choice regarding masks rather than a diocesan mandate. Our staff now includes a full time nurse on duty every school day from 8 am - 3 pm. We have 3 new staff members and a change of role for another. (see page 3.) Our school store is back in swing and the school snack shack run by our student Entrepreneur Club is open during the school day. The ACS Uniform store has been busy selling new and gently used uniforms.

**Our Partners In Education parent** group (P.I.E) are well on their way towards planning our major school fundraisers and family events. Our new student ambassadors have started training with Mrs. McCann, and they did a great job at our back to school Open House and New Family Orientation. We are excited for the opening of the new church, hopefully in October, and the groundbreaking of our new parish administration building on the former site of the old parish hall/middle school building.

# Monthly Fruit of the Spirit Awards

Have you heard of the Fruits of the Spirit? Here is a brief background of what they are...In his letter to the Galatians, St. Paul lists the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control (Gal 5:22-23). These fruits emanate or proceed from the Holy Spirit and reveal what the Holy Spirit is like. These are the Holy Spirit's character traits. And because the Holy Spirit is a Person of the Most Holy Trinity, and because the three Persons are one, the fruits reveal what God is like.

The grace and power of the Holy Spirit gives an increase to these fruits. A confirmed person cooperates with this grace, and with growth in holiness, these fruits expand and intensify.(*ref. Father Van Sloun*)

Teachers at ACS are given the opportunity to reward students with our monthly Fruit of the Spirit awards. Each month a different fruit is highlighted and awards are given to a select group of students at our community prayer service. We encourage everyone to know the Fruits of the Spirit and work hard to live our lives with these special characteristics.
