

## Monthly Fruit of the Spirit Awards

Have you heard of the Fruits of the Spirit? Here is a brief background of what they are...In his letter to the Galatians, St. Paul lists the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control (Gal 5:22-23). These fruits emanate or proceed from the Holy Spirit and reveal what the Holy Spirit is like. These are the Holy Spirit's character traits. And because the Holy Spirit is a Person of the Most Holy Trinity, and because the three Persons are one, the fruits reveal what God is like.

The grace and power of the Holy Spirit gives an increase to these fruits. A confirmed person cooperates with this grace, and with growth in holiness, these fruits expand and intensify. (ref. Father Van Sloun)

Teachers at ACS are given the opportunity to reward students with our monthly Fruit of the Spirit awards. Each month a different fruit is highlighted and awards are given to a select group of students at our community prayer service. We encourage everyone to know the Fruits of the Spirit and work hard to live our lives with these special characteristics.


On August 17, our students attended the first school day Mass with their classmates. Our students attend Mass together weekly. It's a great way to start the school day!




