# Yearly Agenda Items: OCTOBER - Mission & Ministry Focus

#### Goal 1:

Annunciation Catholic School will enhance its Catholic Identity by improving the preparation of teachers to be catechetical leaders and models of the faith to their students.

Objective 1.1: To develop a plan through which all current teachers are certified catechists, and all new teachers can easily achieve certification within 3 years and then have a plan for each teacher's renewal.

- 1.All current non-certified teachers as well as new teachers completed the first two courses in the new teacher catechist program.
- 2. Designated time provided for teachers to complete the 4 online course. Time is built into staff days and/or subsprovided to release the teachers during the school day.
- 3. A fully developed and differentiated plan that addresses catechist training for each teacher is created and followed.
- 4. All teachers certified by Sept. 2026\* Principal will lead the development and adjustment of school calendar and schedule.
- \*Parish manager, certified Kino instructor, may provide some of the renewal courses Teachers will attend the courses and manage their certification and renewal plan Cost of diocesan program Designated time on staff days for the online sessions

Objective 1.2: To provide more faith formation opportunities annually for teachers beyond that required for catechist certification.

- 1. Teachers provided with a monthly schedule of all adult faith formation at St. Gabriel.
- 2. Teachers surveyed for faith related topics they would like to see offered
- 3. Members of the parish and school community identified as able and willing to provide a faith formation activity on the topics requested.
- 4. At least 5 faith formation activities scheduled per year during contracted staff days
  Objective 1.3: To provide adequate teacher collaboration time during the school year to develop, implement, and continuously improve the effectiveness of student faith formation.
- 1. Conduct a survey of teachers to determine which want/need to collaborate
